



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

2020 URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE

Vista Irrigation District (District) is in the process of preparing and updating its 2020 Urban Water Management Plan (2020 UWMP) in compliance with the Urban Water Management Planning Act (Act) and the Water Conservation Act of 2009, commonly referred to as SBX7-7; an update of the District's UWMP is required every five years. The 2020 UWMP update will reflect the District's plan to reliably meet future water needs within its service area and compliance with SBX7-7. It will describe how the District will respond to foreseeable and unforeseeable water shortages; as part of the Act's new requirements, the District will also be adopting a Water Supply Response Program (WSRP), also referred to as a Water Shortage Contingency Plan, which must be included as part of the 2020 UWMP.

A copy of the District's draft 2020 UWMP and WSRP will be available for review on the District's website (www.vidwater.org/public-notices) in late May 2021, and the District will subsequently hold a noticed public hearing on the 2020 UWMP and WSRP in advance of its proposed adoption on June 16, 2021. A copy of the draft 2020 UWMP and WSRP will also be available for public review outside the District lobby during normal business hours at the District's office located at 1391 Engineer Street, Vista, CA 92081.
